



Cotton Kings Girl Cardigan

Sizes: 2-4 (5-7) (8-10) (11-13) years

Skill Level: Intermediate

Crochet Hook: 4 mm (US size 7)

Materials: 4 Stitch markers, 6 buttons.

Yarn: Twirls Deluxe - in color
Chameleon (32)

How much yarn do you need?

2-4, 5-7, 8-10 years: 1 cake

11-13 years: 2 cakes

Gauge: Shell pattern (1 sh + 1 sc)

5 Shell x 11 Rows = 10x10 cm

Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Ch - Chain

St - Stitch

Sc - Single Crochet

Dc - Double Crochet

Hdc - Half Double Crochet

Sl st - Slip Stitch

S - Stitch Marker

Sh - Shell = *2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc* in same
st

Inc = Increase = (*1 hdc, ch 1* x3, 1
hdc) in the same stitch. Place the **S** in the
space created by the central ch.

Pattern notes:

- The chains in the beginning of the row count as the first stitch.
- The rows starting with dc always have 1 sh above the first sc of the previous row.
- The cardigan is worked top down. We will start with the yoke, then separate the body from the sleeves and work the 3 parts individually.
- For a better result, you will need to cut the yarn at each shadow change and work the sleeves with this color too.
- Instructions for sizes 5-7, 8-10 and 11-13 years are written in between brackets.

Description for website: This Girl's Cardigan is a classic Raglan, worked in basic stitches, but using colorful shades to make it more special.

Pattern

Ch 76 (84) (96) (104), 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1 sc in each ch until the end of the row = 75 (83) (95) (103) sts in total.

Row 1: Ch 3, 3 dc, *skip 1, 1 sh in next st, skip 1, 1 sc in next* Repeat from *to* 17 (18) (21) (23) times. Skip 1, 1 sh in next, skip 1 and finish the row with 4 dc = 18 (19) (22) (24) sh in total.

Row 2: Ch 1, 3 sc, *1 sc in the chain space of the previous row of sh, 1 sh in the sc of the previous row* Repeat from *to* until you have 3 (3) (3) (4) sh for the front part. Continue with 1 inc in the chain space of the previous row of sh, place the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* Repeat from *to* 1 (1) (2) (2) times. Now you have 2 (2) (3) (3) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 inc, place the **S**. 1 sh, *1 sc, 1 sh* Repeat from *to* until you have 7 (8) (9) (9) sh for the back. Continue with 1 inc, place the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* Repeat from *to* 1 (1) (2) (2) times. Now you have 2 (2) (3) (3) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 inc, place the **S**. 1 sh *1 sc, 1 sh* Repeat from *to* until you have 3 (3) (3) (4) sh for the front part. End with 4 sc = 17 (18) (21) (23) sh in total.

Row 3: Ch 3, 3 dc, *1 sh, 1 sc* Repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times until you reach the inc. Put 1 sh in the space below the first ch of the inc. Now you have a total of 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Continue with 1 sc in the second space of the inc, move the **S**. 1 sh in the third space of inc *1 sc, 1 sh* Repeat from *to* 1 (1) (2) (2) times, 1 sc, 1 sh over the inc from the previous row. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 sc, move the **S**. 1 sh on



inc, 1 sc *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 6 (7) (8) (8) times, 1 sh on inc. Now you have a total of 8 (9) (10) (10) sh for the back part. Continue with 1 sc, move the **S**. 1 sh, *1 sc, 1 sh* Repeat from *to* 1 (1) (2) (2) times. 1 sc, 1 sh over inc. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 sc, move the **S**. 1 sh on inc *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times. Now you have a total of 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Finish with 4 dc.

Row 4: Ch 1, 3 sc, *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times, 1 sc. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (3) (4) sh for the front part. Put 1 sh in the corner and move the **S**. *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 2 (2) (3) (3) times, 1 sc. Now you have a total of 2 (2) (3) (3) sh for the sleeve. Put 1 sh in the corner and move the **S**. *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 7 (8) (9) (9) times, 1 sc. Now you have a total of 7 (8) (9) (9) sh for the back part. Put 1 sh in the corner and move the **S**. *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 2 (2) (3) (3) times, 1 sc. Now you have a total of 2 (2) (3) (3) sh for the sleeve. Put 1 sh in the corner and move the **S**. *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times, 1 sc. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (3) (4) sh for the front part. Finish with 4 sc.

Row 5: Ch 3, 3 dc, *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times, 1 sh. Now you have a total of 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Continue with 1 inc and move the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 2 (2) (3) (3) times, 1 sh. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 inc and move the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 7 (8) (9) (9) times, 1 sh. Now you have a total of 8 (9) (10) (10) sh for the back part. Continue with 1 inc and move the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 2 (2) (3) (3) times, 1 sh. Now you have a total of 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 Inc and move the **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* 3 (3) (3) (4) times, 1 sh. Now you have a total of 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Finish with 4 dc.

Row 6: Ch 1, 3 sc, *1 sc, 1 sh* repeat from *to* until you have:

- 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part and place **S** over sc.
- 4 (4) (5) (4) sh for the sleeve and place **S**
- 9 (10) (11) (11) sh for the back part and place **S**
- 4 (4) (5) (4) sh for the sleeve and place **S**
- 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part

Finish with 1 sc, 4 sc.

Row 7: Ch 3, 3 dc, *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* until you have 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Continue with 1 sh in the corner and place **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* until you have 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 sh in the corner and place **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to*



until you have 8 (9) (10) (10) sh for the back part. Continue with 1 sh in the corner and place **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* until you have 3 (3) (4) (4) sh for the sleeve. Continue with 1 sh in the corner and place **S**. *1 sh, 1 sc* repeat from *to* until you have 4 (4) (4) (5) sh for the front part. Finish with 4 dc.

Repeat rows 2-7 obtaining the following sh number:

Row 8: 4 (4)(4)(5) **S** inc, 3 (3)(4)(4) **S** inc, 8 (9)(10)(10) **S** inc, 3 (3)(4)(4) **S** inc, 4 (4)(4)(5).

Row 9: 5 (5)(5)(6) **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, 9 (10)(11)(11) **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, 5 (5)(5)(6).

Row 10: 4 (4)(4)(5), sh **S**, 3 (3)(4)(4), sh **S**, 8 (9)(10)(10), sh, **S**, 3 (3)(4)(4), sh, **S**, 4 (4)(4)(5)

Row 11: 5 (5)(5)(6) **S**, inc, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, inc, 9 (10)(11)(11) **S**, inc, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, inc, 5 (5)(5)(6)

Row 12: 5 (5)(5)(6) **S**, 5 (5)(6)(6) **S**, 10 (11)(12)(12) **S**, 5 (5)(6)(6) **S**, 5 (5)(5)(6)

Row 13: 5 (5)(5)(6), sh **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5), sh **S**, 9 (10)(11)(11), sh **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5), sh **S**, 5 (5)(5)(6)

Row 14: 5 (5)(5)(6) **S**, inc, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, inc, 9 (10)(11)(11) **S**, inc, 4 (4)(5)(5) **S**, inc, 5 (5)(5)(6)

Row 15: 6 (6)(6)(7) **S**, 5 (5)(6)(6) **S**, 10 (11)(12)(12) **S**, 5 (5)(6)(6) **S**, 6 (6)(6)(7)

Row 16: 5 (5)(5)(6, sh **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5), sh **S**, 9 (10)(11)(11), sh **S**, 4 (4)(5)(5), sh **S**, 5 (5)(5)(6)

ONLY FOR SIZE (5/7) (8/10) (11/13)

Row 17: (6)(6)(7) **S**, inc, (5)(6)(6) **S** inc, (11)(12)(12) **S** inc, (5)(6)(6) **S** inc, (6)(6)(7)

Row 18: (6)(6)(7) **S**, (6)(7)(7) **S**, (12)(13)(13) **S**, (6)(7)(7) **S**, (6)(6)(7)

Row 19: (6)(6)(7), sh **S**, (5)(6)(6), sh **S**, (11)(12)(12), sh **S**, (5)(6)(6), sh **S**, (6)(6)(7).

ONLY FOR SIZE (8/10) (11/13)

Row 20: (6)(7) **S** inc, (6)(6) **S** inc, (12)(12) **S** inc, (6)(6) **S** inc, (6)(7)

Row 21: (7)(8) **S**, (7)(7) **S**, (13)(13) **S**, (7)(7) **S**, (7)(8)

Row 22: (6)(7), sh **S**, (6)(6), sh **S**, (12)(12), sh **S**, (6)(6), sh **S**, (6)(7)

TOTAL SH = 31 (37) (40) (42)

Body

Row 1: Now we move the markers to the sc st after the sh number indicated:

- Front: 4 (5) (6) (7)
- Sleeve: 7 (8) (8) (8)
- Back: 9 (11) (12) (12)



Ch 1, 3 sc, 4 (5) (6) (7) sh (place the last sh in the stitch with the **S**). Ch 8, skip the sts for the sleeve and put 1 sc in the next marked stitch **S** for the beginning of the back part. Ch 3 (this counts as the first dc of the sh stitch) finish the sh stitch. Continue with sh stitches until you have a total of 9 (11) (12) (12) sh including the 2 over the **S**. At the end of the back part: Ch 8, skip the sts for the sleeve and put 1 sc in the next marked stitch **S** for the beginning of the front part. Ch 3, 1 sh over the sc for a total of 4 (5)(6)(7). Continue with sh till the end of the row. Finish with 1 sc, 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, 3 dc, 4 (5) (6) (7) sh (finish with sc), 1 sh, 1 sc, 1 sh over the chain. Continue working the back and make the same increase in the other chains. Finish with 4 dc. You should have a total of 21 (25) (28) (30) sh.

Keep working the rows without any further increase and alternate rows starting with dc and sc. I finished with a total length of 42 (46) (53) (56) cm but you can decide your favorite length.

Sleeves

If you are using a color changing yarn, you have 2 options for the sleeves:

1. Cut the yarn at each color change and make an irregular part of the sleeve.
2. Finish the cardigan with the first part of the cake and make the sleeves with the last part.

We can work in round and spiral but be careful to use a marker and always be sure not to lose any sh. Also remember that when working in the round you will have a right and a wrong side, be sure to make both sleeves on the right side.

Row 1: We will start the sleeves by adding 2 sh corresponding to the 2 on the body. Put 1 sc in the last sh before the ch and place the **S** in this sc, 1 sh, 1 sc, 1 sh in the chain and keep working the same way as the body. For a total of 9 (10) (10) (10) sh.

Row 2: *1 sh (place **S** over this sh), 1 sc* repeat from *to* and finish with 1 sc.

Row 3: *1 sc (place **S** over this sc), 1 sh* repeat from *to* and finish with 1 sh.

Repeat rows 2-3 until you have a total of 30 (35) (38) (40) cm from row 1. Don't cut the yarn because we will finish with the last color.

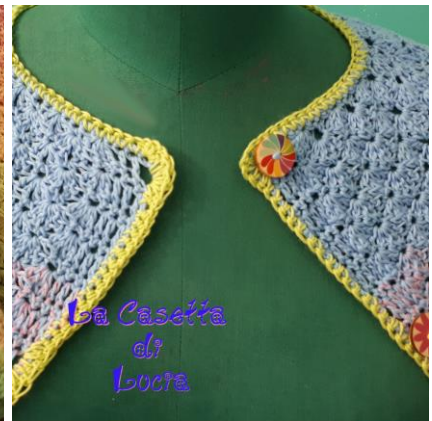


Finish

Now it's time to add the buttons. I attached them on every 6th dc row. You can also add a 2 row edge around the cardigan and the button slots:

Row 1: 1 sc on the side of each sc and 2 sc on the sides of each dc. In the corners, make 2 sc in the last stitch.

Row 2: 1 sc in each sc but in the corresponding rows of buttons. I made the 4 sc (1 from the sc before the dc and 2 from the dc and 1 from the sc after the dc) entering the space between the 2nd and 3rd dc of the front. Also in this row remember to make 2 sc in the sc in each corner. Finish with 1 sl st at the end and cut the yarn.
